# Enrolling your child in Foundation (prep)

**2024** - Apply now to enrol your child in Foundation (Prep) for 2024. The Department of Education has released a new statewide timeline for enrolling in Foundation (Prep) for the 2024 school year.

If you have a child starting primary school in 2024, it's time to enrol. Make sure to submit your enrolment application by Friday 28 July 2023. If you are enrolling the sibling of a student at our school for Foundation in 2024, and both children will be attending our school at the same time, your child is prioritised for a place at our school as per the department's Placement Policy.

It is important to follow the statewide timeline to enrol your child in Foundation. Enrolling your child in line with the timelines allows us to plan our classrooms, staffing and transition activities and ensures your child has the best start to school.

Year 6 to Year 7 Placement Application – There are still some Gr 6 parents who have not returned the application for Yr 6 to Yr 7 placement forms, which were send home last week. These forms <u>must be returned</u> even if your child is attending a private secondary school in 2024, as we need to know where to transfer your child's information at the end of the school year.

**General Reminder** - Food allergies are becoming increasingly common among children. We wish to advise we currently have student/s in your child's classroom who have severe allergy to nuts and/or other allergens - any exposure to these items, even a tiny amount, could be potentially very serious and life threatening for these children.

We ask our students and families to help make the school environment safer for all students, by following these simple suggestions:

- Please, where possible, try and avoid sending any foods that contain nuts, such as peanut butter or nutella sandwiches, muesli or health bars with nuts, to school with your child.
- Please always contact the Classroom Teacher *before* sending any food for sharing with the class for special celebrations like birthdays, Easter or Christmas.
- Please remind your child never to share his/her food and drinks with other students.
- Please wash your child's face and hands thoroughly before they leave home, especially if your child has eaten nuts/allergens prior to coming to school.
- Please remind your child often to wash their hands before and after eating.

We greatly appreciate your support for children with food allergies. Together we can make a difference.
